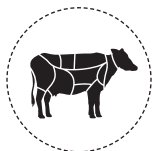

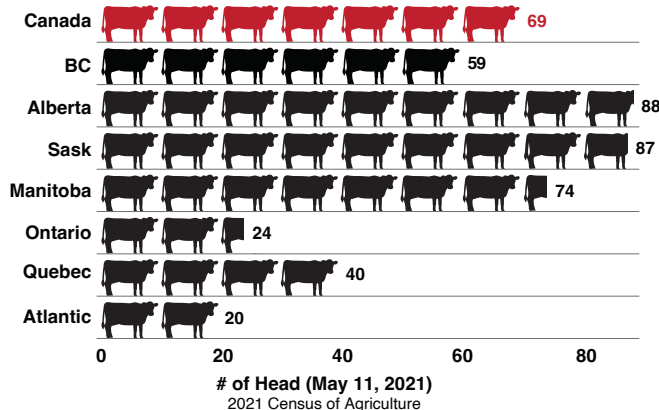

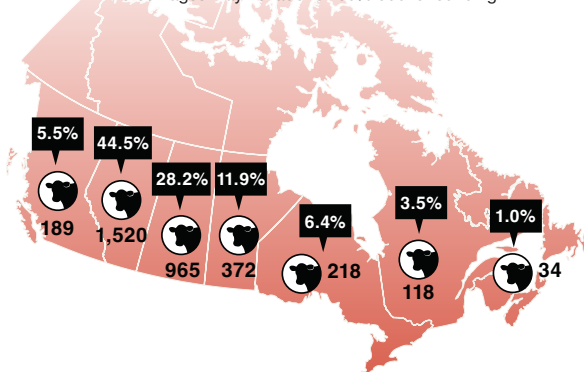

Average # of Beef Cows per Farm Reporting Beef Cows

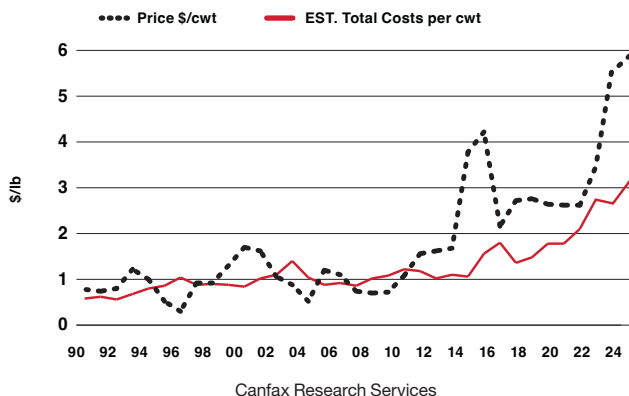


Beef Cows by Province

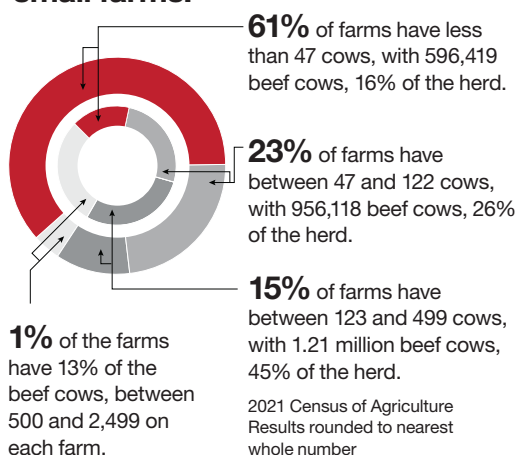


Average Cost of Production vs. Average Returns on an Alberta 550 lb Calf

The majority of farms reporting beef cows on cow-calf, stocking and finishing operations are small farms:



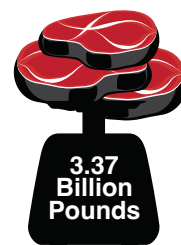
Canada fed **3.02 million cattle** in 2025 (finished to market weight) down 4% from 2024.

Western Canada finishes **77%** of all fed cattle in Canada. Canfax

In 2025, Canada produced **3.37 billion pounds of beef**, (including offals), down 3.7% from 2024.

Cattle and calf cash receipts in 2025 totaled **\$20.6 billion**, up 23% from 2024. Statistics Canada

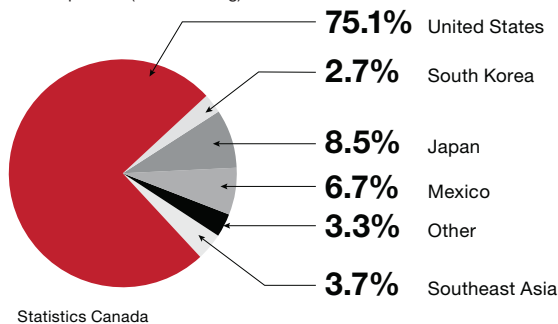
Beef production contributed **\$41 billion** to Canada's GDP (2023-2025 average).

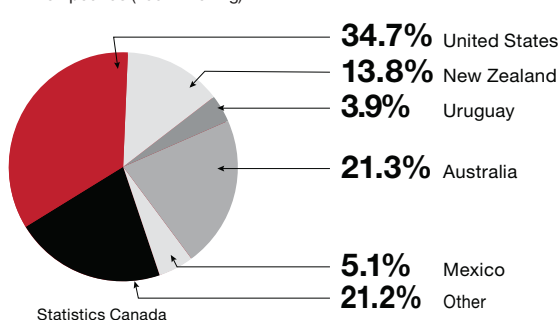
Beef Exports – 2025

In 2025, Canada exported **54%** of total beef and cattle produced in Canada.

In 2025, **47%** of Canadian production was exported (excluding slaughter cattle).

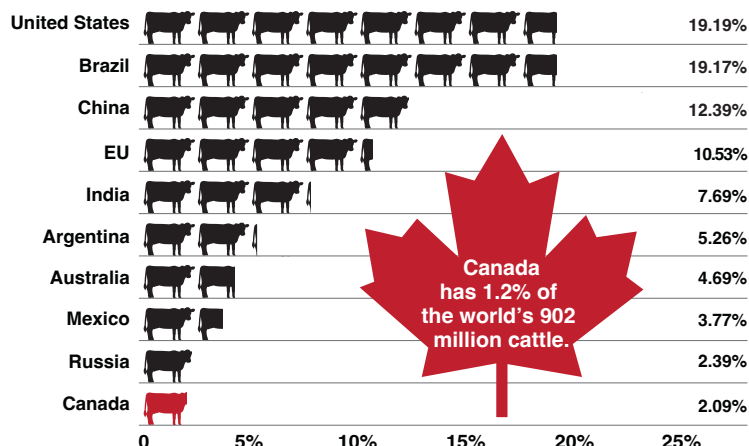

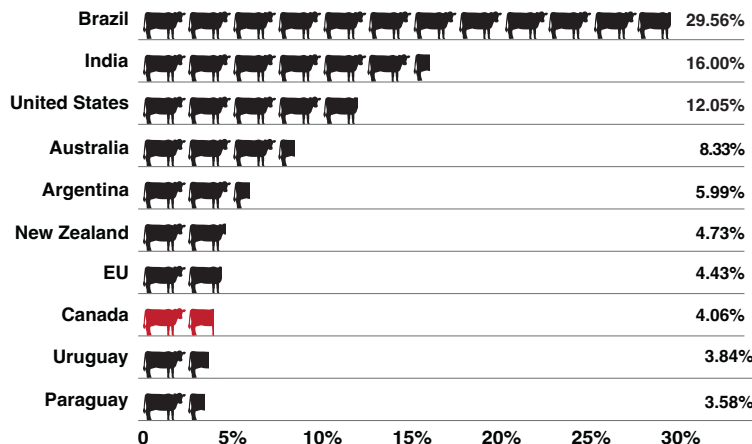
Top 10 Beef Producing Nations – 2026f



Canada produces 2% of the world's beef supply. Worldwide beef production is forecast to be 61.0 million metric tonnes in 2026.

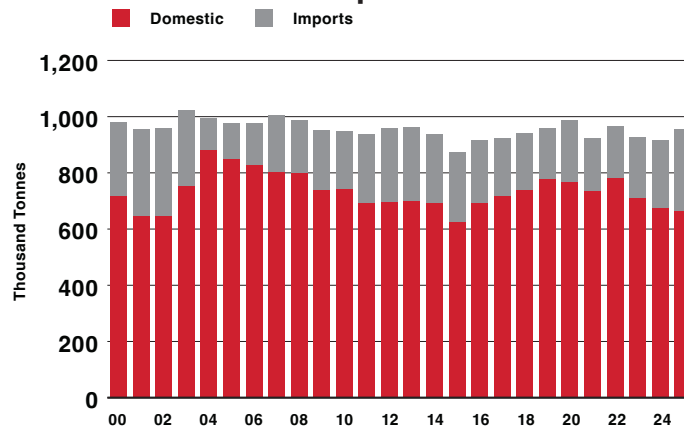
Top 10 Beef Exporting Nations – 2026f (excludes live slaughter exports)



Total world exports in 2026 are forecast to be 13.5 million metric tonnes and Canada is projected to be the 8th largest beef exporter in the world (excluding live slaughter exports).
